Yanco Public School, a proud member of the Leeton Community of Public Schools, is located in the rural village of Yanco, approximately five kilometres south of Leeton, the gateway to the vibrant Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area.

The school is classified as a TP2 with a Teaching Principal, two full-time classroom teachers, a School Learning Support Officer, School Administration Manager and General Assistant.

Students actively participate in a wide range of sport, social activities and the performing arts.

Supported by strong community involvement and an active and hardworking P&C, the school provides a happy, safe and caring environment in which to learn and work.



Yanco Public School Little Learners

Yanco Public School understands that providing early learning experiences is an important step in securing your child's successful transition into the school setting, but is sometimes difficult for parents to manage. Our school is committed to providing enriching activities to all children and students and in 2018 will continue our Little Learners Program.

Little Learners is a free, year-long transition program which follows the Australian Early Years Learning Framework. This is a national Early Learning Framework for children from birth to five years of age. The framework's vision is for all children to experience playbased learning that is engaging and builds success for life.

Little Learners will use the framework to ensure that your child receives a high quality experience and will provide them with the skills to succeed at school. It is designed to help familiarise both you and your child with our school environment so that you are both confident and happy at our school. The opportunity also enables potential new students and parents to develop positive relationships with members of the school community.

Yanco Public School's Little Learners Program is aimed at children from 3 to 5 years of age. It will commence on **Friday, 2 March 2018 with the last session to take place on Friday, 16 November 2018**. Each session will run from 9.30 am to 12.00 pm and children will be in the care of an experienced teacher, with the support of a School Learning and Support Officer.

Students who intend enrolling in Kindergarten in 2019 will also be able to attend Yanco Public School's Kindergarten Transition Program, which will run independently of Little Learners in Terms 3 and 4 2018. *Please note priority for placements in Little Learners will be given to students intending to enrol in Kindergarten in Yanco Public School.*

Children will need to bring a hat, drink and something for recess and parents will not be required to stay for the session.

Information packages for 2018 can be collected from the office at any time or mailed out to prospective parents. The package will include an enrolment form, which must be completed before your child can attend Little Learners.
