Dear Parents and Carers,

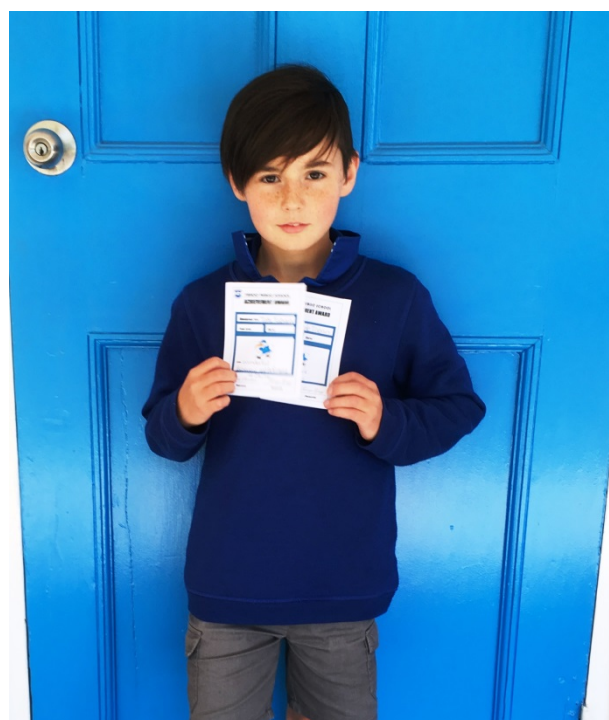
Chaplain's Report
