Learning support is already off to a very productive start with all students returning refreshed and ready to learn!

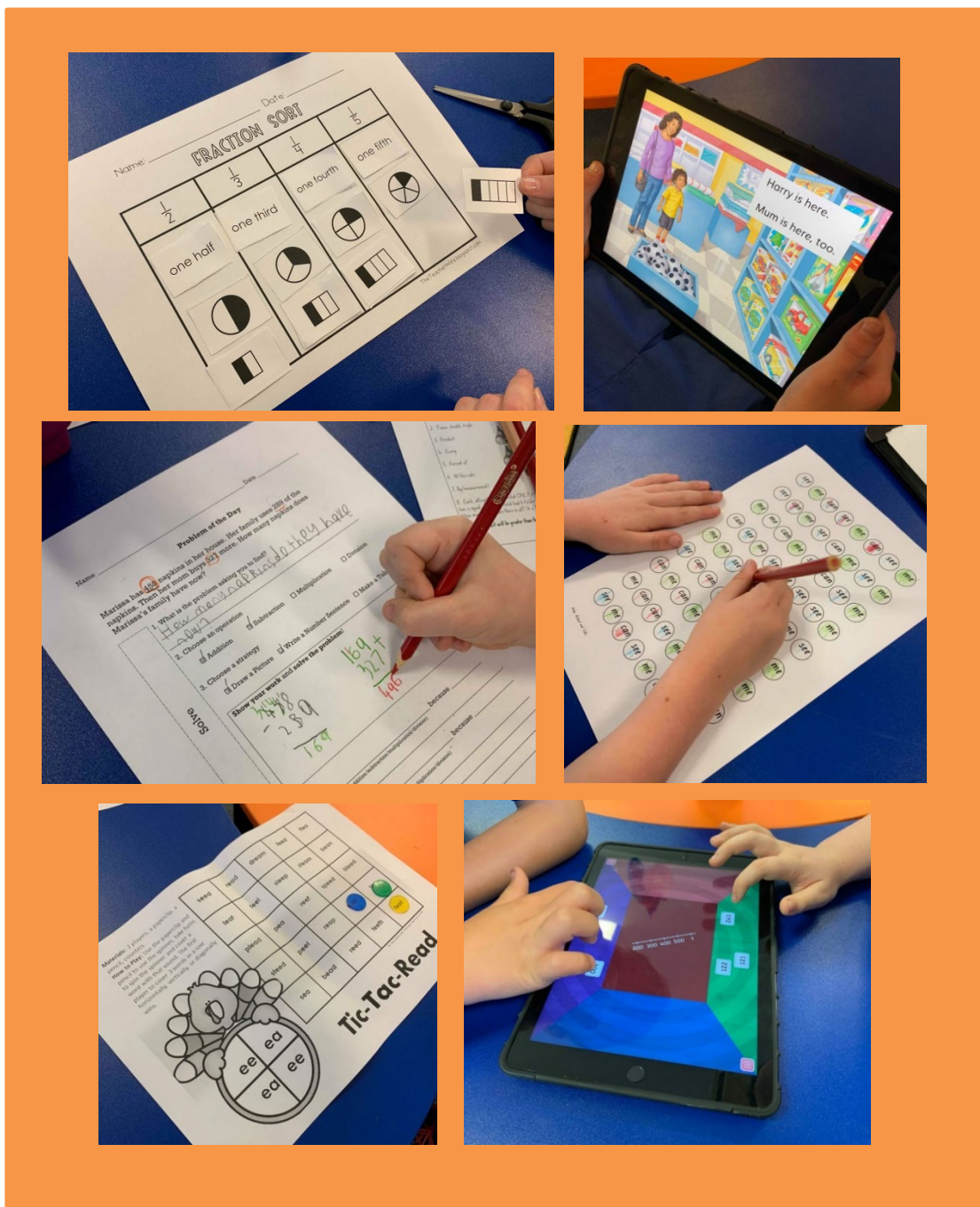

Some activities students have enjoyed completing so far include:

- fraction sorting activities;
- colouring sight word dots by colour;
- reading PM readers on the ipads;
- practising our quick math facts using apps such as 'maths slide';
- correcting errors in sample texts and adding adjectives to make them more interesting;
- completing maths word problems and explaining operations used;
