### **Survey results and Technology Meeting Mr Powter's Classroom Thursday, Week 8 (time to be confirmed)**

Last year our parent and community survey revealed that the aesthetics of the school grounds was an important area to focus on and improve at Yanco Public School.

Following on from the survey feedback of 2018:

- New garden beds will be placed in the main corner of the school and along the main road under the gum trees
- Murals have been planned and completed
- The Kitchen Garden room was created
- Screen covers were placed on the boards on external walls to allow for the display of student artwork
