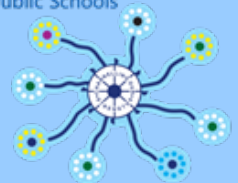

Evie, *Lacey* and *Bella* all had a go at the trickier puzzles last week and never gave up. Great job *Evie*, *Lacey* and *Bella*!

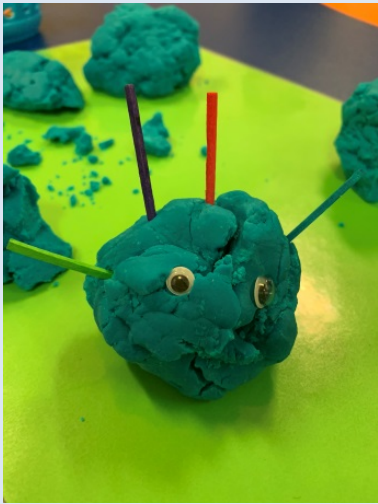
Max took great care when colouring in a dinosaur picture at the colouring table and building a tall tower for a little dinosaur toy to sit on.
