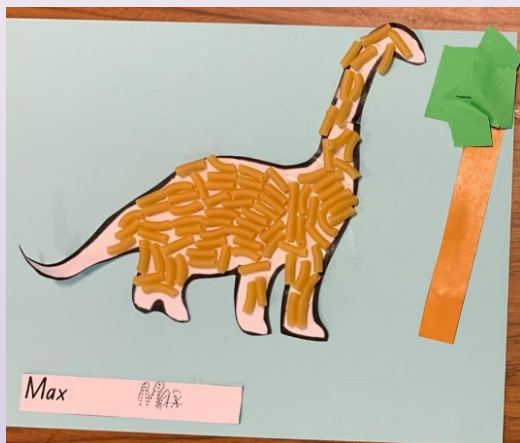




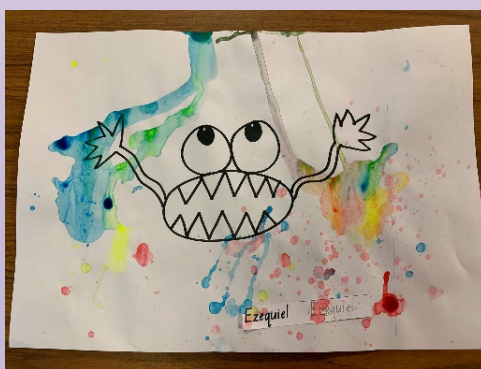
# Little Learners
