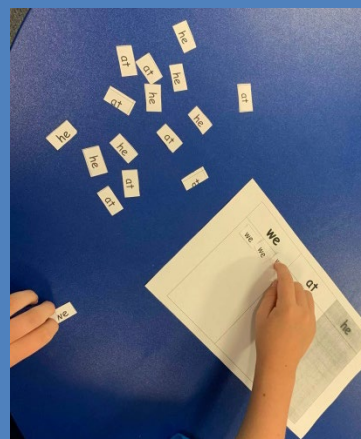
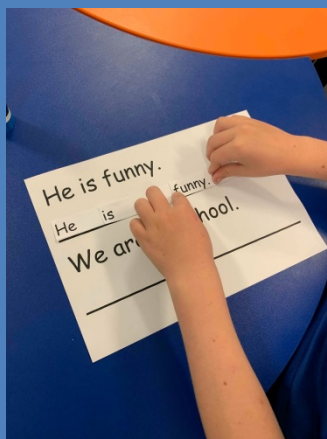
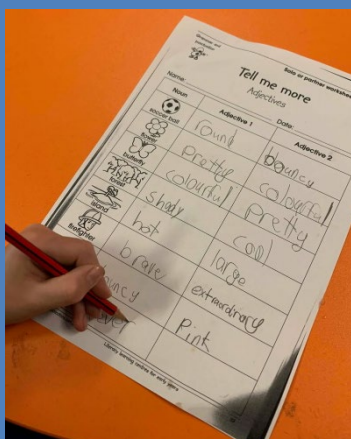
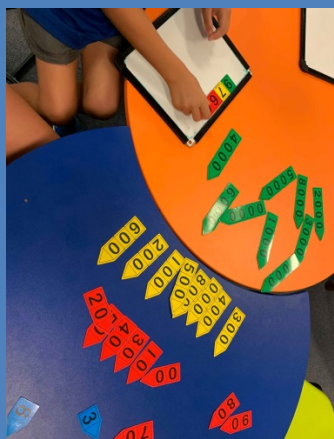
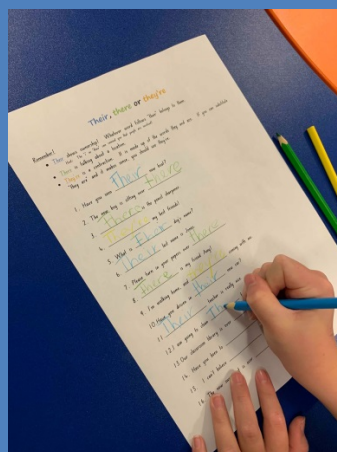
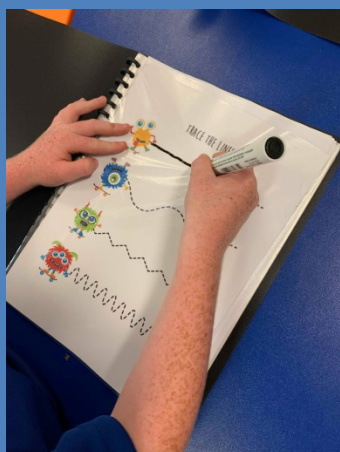
Learning Support News

All learning support students have been working really well and I have been very impressed with their attitude to learning. Activities undertaken during our sessions so far this term have included:

- name writing and pencil control;
- making groups of specific numbers with 'bug' counters;
- selecting the correct homophone for selected sentences;
- looking at different ways to make numerals to 10 using dominoes;
- 'dabbing' CVC word ducks that rhyme with bingo markers;
- using our new 'magnetic place value arrows' resource when revising our addition and subtraction skills;
- thinking of adjectives which effectively describe nouns to improve the descriptive language in writing;
- and re-constructing sentences with sight words to learn and sorting these words into columns.

Letters outlining support being received will be sent home once learning support work groups being trialled are officially finalised.
