#### Kindergarten Transition/Little Learners Home Learning Packs




## **K.1 Classroom News**

### K.1 Writing...


Over the past few weeks K.1 have been constructing their own narratives. Each student is writing about the same plot and all students have come up with their own adventure for each of their characters.


Stage 1/2 are reading the novel 'Charlotte's Web'. We have inspired a lot of our learning in class on the wonderful novel by E.B White.


