Veggie Patch News

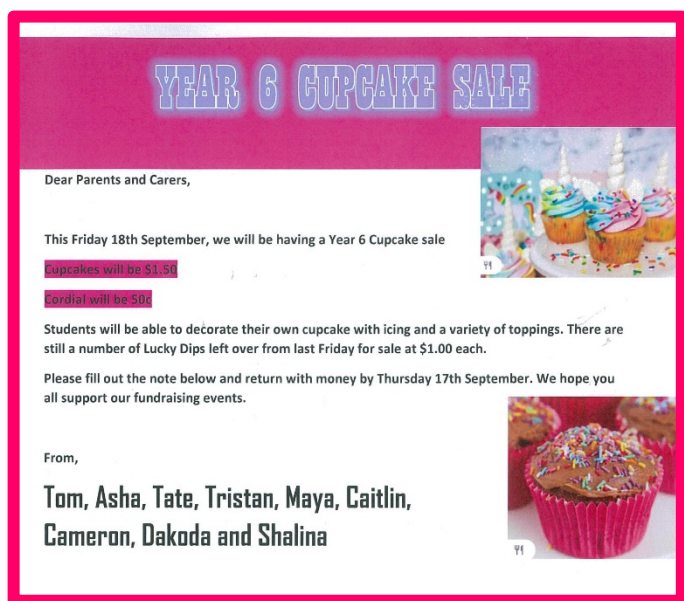

K.1 Classroom News



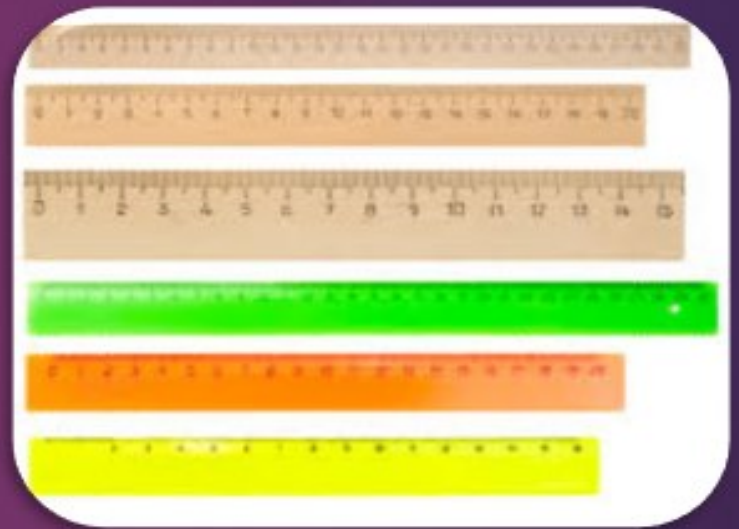
K.1 literacy...

Spring pigs are born during this lovely season of the year.

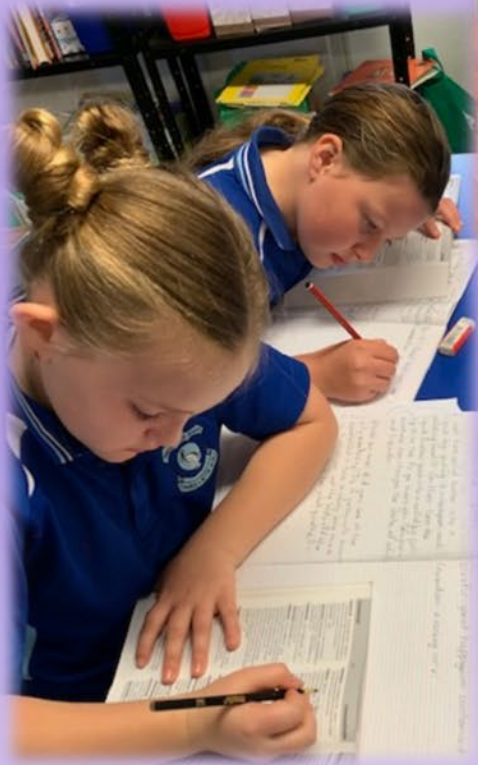

Stage 2/3 Class News


Students in the Stage 2/3 class are learning about procedure writing this semester. As part of their learning, students were given a recipe for Chocolate Fudge Brownie, however, some of the key steps were missing! Students had to work out the missing steps to successfully cook their chocolate treat.



Chocolate Fudge Brownie

Brownie	Frosting
100g butter	50g butter
2 eggs	15mL milk
20mL water	

1. Preheat the [redacted] to 180 degrees Celsius.
2. Grease a 5cm deep by 20cm square brownie pan.
3. Line the base with [redacted].
4. Place the [redacted] into a medium bowl.
5. Mix with a [redacted] until mixture is [redacted].

6. Spread the [redacted].
 7. Bake for 30-35 minutes or until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out with a few moist crumbs.
 8. Allow to [redacted] completely in the pan.
 9. Place [redacted] into a small mixing bowl.
 10. Using an electric beater on low speed, mix for 3 minutes to combine, scraping down the sides occasionally.
 11. [redacted] over the top of the [redacted] brownie slice.

Children who can adequately draw the oblique cross can copy a significantly higher number of letters than little ones who cannot.
