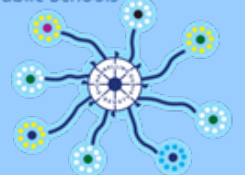

Yesterday, our whole school went to Griffith Pioneer Park Museum. Students were taught about their local history and some of the characters that have made this area great. This took us all over the village and taught us about different buildings, scar trees and the impact that different people had on the landscape. 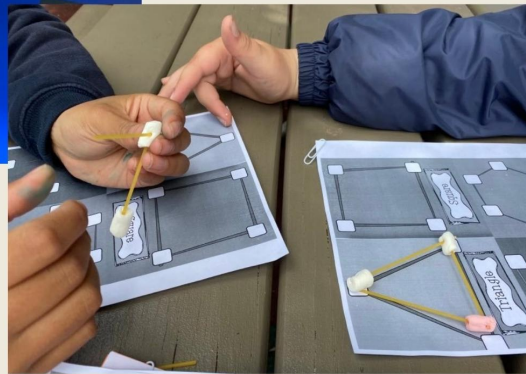
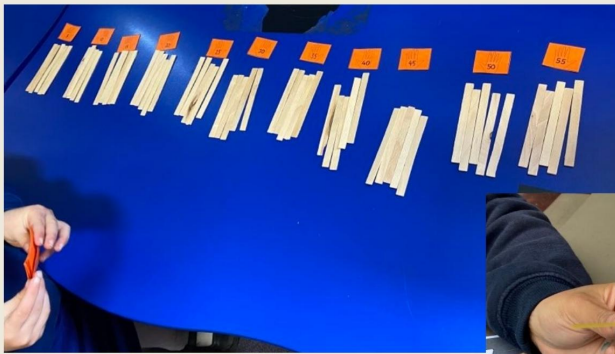
