### **School Communication**

The school has a variety of ways we work with you to connect and communicate

Newsletter- This is published and printed on even weeks. We would love it if more families supported us to transition to the paperless version. Please let us know if you would rather not get a paper copy. We see many of these left outside classrooms. The newsletters can be viewed on our website, via a link on Facebook and on Sentral.

Facebook – Teaching staff share the amazing things that happen with the community on this page. We also use it to update you on changes in times and when students are returning from excursions.

The School Website - This is maintained and updated on a fortnightly basis. Past newsletters are also kept here.

Sentral – this is a our main communication for attendance and is where you can go and check for upcoming events on the school calendar.

### **Attendance**

It is a legal requirement that all students arrive on time and attend school each day. If there is a reason that they are not able to attend please contact the school either by leaving a message on the school answering machine or by a letter on the day they return. If a student has been absent for 3 days without notification we are required to contact you. This will be either via a text or a phone call. If you know ahead of time that there is an appointment, please send in a note with this information. As a school, we can proudly say that the majority of students are attending school 95% of the time. This has a big impact on both their learning and their ability to maintain friendships.

We have an On Time in Line raffle each week and student are able to enter this when they are at school before the morning bell.

### School times including before and after school supervision

Supervision of students before school begins at **8:40** each day. Before this time there is no teacher on playground duty. The first school bus arrives at 8:20 and the one teacher who is guaranteed to be on site for the early bus students has a list of those students. We do not provide before and after school care and if we do not know your child is in the school we cannot guarantee their safety. All students who arrive before 8:40 will be having a note sent home to confirm the bus they are arriving on.

### **School Voluntary Contributions**

Each year the school asks for a small contribution towards the resourcing of the school. Thank you to those families who have already contributed this year. This amount remains at \$40 per students and is used to purchase stationary items for the classroom and other items that enhance learning.

### Thank you for the support

It is the spirit of the community that really does make this one of the best schools that I have had the privilege to be a member of and this week I would like to say a very big thank you to these families.

The Sloan family have spent their holiday break making sure our school chickens are well loved and nurtured. Each holiday period they kindly offer to care for the hens and keep them safe.

The McWhinnie family have very generously gifted the school a new sound system. No longer will you need to strain to hear because the PA has failed us. I know the kids are all very excited to get use of this great system during recess and lunch and as part of the PDHPE and dance programs.

Helen Hopewell answered our call at the end of last year and donated her time and skills to sew custom made chair bags for each of the students in K/1. As you can see, they not only brighten up the classroom, but make for easy storage of books.

The P and C are always quietly working in the background raising funds for the betterment of our students. Even during the holiday period, they were at the club each fortnight running the raffle on behalf of our school. # Year 2/3 Classroom News


